






Your Second Act by Patricia Heaton Release Date: 07/21/2020


God of War by Jeff Rovin Release Date: 8/4/2020

After the devastating outbreak of a killer super virus, the Black Wasp Team must prevent America's enemies from gaining access to the most dangerous weapon the world has ever seen.




The Invention Of Sound by Chuck Palahniuk Release Date: 9/8/2020


The Hollow Ones by Guillermo Del Toro Release Date: 8/11/2020


How To Be An Antiracist by Ibram X. Kendi Release Date: 08/11/2020
