


An Easy Death by Charlaine Harris Release Date: 7/1/2020


The Order by Daniel Silva Release Date: 7/14/2020


Gone by Midnight by Candice Fox Release Date: 8/01/2020


The Lions of Fifth Avenue by Fiona Davis Release Date: 8/4/2020
